JOIN PAKISTAN ARMY AS 'M CADET'

1. Eligibility Conditions

a. **Qualification**

Candidates studying in 4th / final year MBBS in Medical Colleges recognized by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) will be eligible.

- b. **Age**: 20-26 years as on **27 September 2020.**
- c. **Gender**: Male
- d. Marital Status: Unmarried
- e. **Nationality**: Citizen of Pakistan and domicile holders of Azad Kashmir Gilgit Baltistan. Upon final selection, candidates with dual nationality will have to surrender nationalities other than Pakistani.

f. **Physical Standards**

(1) Minimum Height : 5'-4" or (162.5 cm).

(2) Weight : As per Body Mass Index.

2. **Ineligibility Conditions**

- a. A candidate is ineligible if he is:-
 - (1) Twice rejected by Inter Selection Services Board for Post Graduate Entry.
 - (2) Twice rejected by Inter Selection Services Board for Intermediate Graduate (Pakistan Military Academy/ Graduate/ Equivalent) and once rejected by Inter Selection Services Board or General Headquarters/ Naval Headquarters/ Air Headquarters based selection boards.
 - (3) Once rejected by Inter Services Selection Board for Intermediate/
 Graduate (Pakistan Military Academy/ Graduate/ Equivalent) and twice
 rejected by Inter Selection Services Board or General Headquarters/
 Naval Headquarters/ Air Headquarters based selection boards.
 - (4) Twice **not recommended** for 'M' Cadet by General Headquarters/ Air Headquarters/ Navel Headquarters Selection Boards.
 - (5) Twice screened out by Inter Selection Services Board.
 - (6) Dismissed/ removed/ debarred from Government Services including Armed Forces.
 - (7) Convicted in a Court of Law for any heinous offence (to be ascertained by competent military authority).
 - (8) Permanently declared UNFIT by Appeal Medical Board (AMB).

- (9) Declared medically unfit due to Hepatitis B & C. Appeal Medical Board (AMB) cannot be requested.
- (10) Withdrawn from any bonded Armed Forces College/ institution on disciplinary grounds.
- (11) Withdrawn/ discharged/ resigned or purchase of commission from any Armed Forces Academy/ Training Institution of Armed Forces on any ground.
- (12) Tampering of academic certificates/ forgery/ concealment to get undue advantage will make an applicant permanently ineligible for all types of commission in Armed Forces.
- 3. <u>Registration and Preliminary Selection Procedure</u>. Candidates can register either through internet on website www.joinpakarmy.qov.pk or by visiting nearest Army Selection and Recruitment Centre (AS&RC).
 - a. <u>Registration at AS&RCs</u>. The candidates may report at following Army Selection and Recruitment Centres for registration/ allotment of roll no along with necessary documents mentioned in para 4 for completion of registration formalities. The candidates must bring these documents on the date of test as well

 - b. <u>Registration Through Internet</u>. Candidate can register on website <u>www.joinpakarmy.gov.pk</u>. Date and time of test shall be intimated on internet,

for which the individual should have an e-mail account. Candidates will report on exact date and time given for preliminary tests on computerized roll no slip. Date once given will not be changed. Candidates will bring along documents mentioned in para 4. Candidates must attain working knowledge of computer as registration and test will be conducted on computers.

c. <u>Schedule of Registration/ Preliminary Tests</u>. Registration and Preliminary Tests will be held at Army Selection & Recruitment Centres as per the following schedule:-

Registration	1 st to 31 st October 2020
Preliminary Tests	2 to 6 November 2020

d. **Physical Test**

- (1) 1.6 Km run $8^{1/2}$ minutes
- (2) Push Ups 15 repetitions in 2 minutes
- (3) Sits Ups 15 repetitions in 2 minutes
- (4) Chin Ups 3 repetitions in 2 minutes
- (5) Ditch Crossing 7'.4" x 7'.4" with a depth of 4 feet
- e. <u>Preliminary Medical Test</u>. Initial medical tests will be conducted at Army Selection & Recruitment Centres.

f. **Important Points**

- (1) 'M' Cadet, after his enrolment under this Scheme, shall continue to study in the Medical College in which he is on rolls until the completion of his medical graduation and during that period he shall be subject to the Pakistan Army Act, 1952 and rules, regulations & orders issued thereunder.
- (2) On the successful completion of his medical education, basic military training and due satisfaction of other requirements of the scheme, 'M' Cadet will be commissioned in the Army Medical Corps.

g. Merit Criteria

- (1) Results of previous professional exams of MBBS.
- (2) Intelligence / Personality Test at Army Selection & Recruitment Centres.
- (3) Interview by General Headquarters Selection Boards.

4. <u>Documents Required at AS&RCs</u>

- a. 2 x attested photocopies of educational and domicile certificates.
- b. 2 x attested photocopies of Computerized National Identity Card or Form 'B' of candidate and his next of kin (NOK).
- c. 4 x attested passport size photographs.
- d. Candidates will deposit pay order of Rs 500/- clearly indicating 'Payable at any Branch in Pakistan' in favour of Surgeon General/ Director General Medical Services (IS), Medical Directorate/ Director Medical Services-1, General Headquarters Rawalpindi.
- 5. <u>Further Selection</u>. Candidates shortlisted after registration and preliminary tests at Army Selection & Recruitment Centres will receive notice for interviews by the General Headquarters Selection Board through call up letters. Medical Fitness of candidates who are selected in the final interview shall be carried out at nearest Combined Military Hospitals. Final selection will be made at General Headquarters on the basis of candidate's overall performance.

6. Study and Stipend

- a. After enrolment as 'M' Cadet, students will continue to study in their respective Medical Colleges till the completion of Medical graduation.
- b. On the successful completion of his Medical education and basic military training, 'M' Cadets will be commissioned in the Army Medical Corps as Captain.
- c. Selected 'M' Cadets will be entitled to receive Rs 18,583/- as monthly stipend.
- d. After getting commission in Army Medical Corps as Captain, 'M' Cadets will also be entitled to receive lump sum amount not exceeding Rs 222,996/- per annum as re-imbursement of MBBS study expenditures occurred on their Medical education prior to joining the scheme.
- 7. <u>Military Training</u>. 22 x weeks Basic Military Training (BMT) will be conducted at Pakistan Military Academy.
- 8. **Bond**. Finally selected and medically fit candidates will be required to sign a bond to serve the Army for a minimum of six years, after qual of MBBS/ grant of commission in Army Medical Corps.
